DOWNLOADING AND INSTALLING JAVA

- 1. Download and install Java application (Download Java for Windows)
- 2. Once downloaded, run the application downloaded and wait for the installation to complete.
- 3. Once completing step 1 and 2, continue to configuring the Java settings to allow and set the environment to run the ASYCUDA World App.
